STATE OFFICER ELECTIONS

Each adviser will receive login information (login cards) to Simply Voting for their chapter's Voting Delegates via email on Sunday, May 3. Advisers may choose their Voting Delegates from the members attending the virtual conference, and we are asking advisers to send one login card to each of their voting delegates. The number of Voting Delegates assigned to each chapter is based on chapter membership per policy:

- Up to 49 members = 2 Voting Delegates
- 50 to 100 members = 3 Voting Delegates
- 101+ members = 4 Voting Delegates

Using their electronic devices Voting Delegates will go to the Website address shown on their login card and enter their unique passcode, which is also on their login card. They will have one vote for each position. The voting site will open at noon on May 3 and close at noon on May 4.

Please be sure to ask all voting delegates to visit the State Officer Candidates section on the I00xed.tv site. Voting Delegates should start with the first button, which will explain the candidate campaign materials ("campaign booth" expectations) and help them decide who should represent them on the state officer team. The second button contains the PDFs for each region vice president candidate, and the third button contains the PDFs for the state executive team. The PDFs are each candidate's "campaign booth."
