There will be a \$5 charge per test, and will show on your invoice when your registration has been submitted.

The testing window will be open from February 18, 2019 to February 26, 2019, and your testing information will be sent to you directly from TFI, the online testing administrator.

Signing up for role play testing does not obligate a team to attend SBLC. If they are not in the top 15 of the test results, they will not be eligible to compete in these events at SBLC. If they are in the top 15, and they choose not to advance to SBLC, the number of teams presenting will be reduced - we will not bump up other teams.

There are no exceptions to the timeline for role play testing.
