WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW TO FUNDRAISE FOR MOD

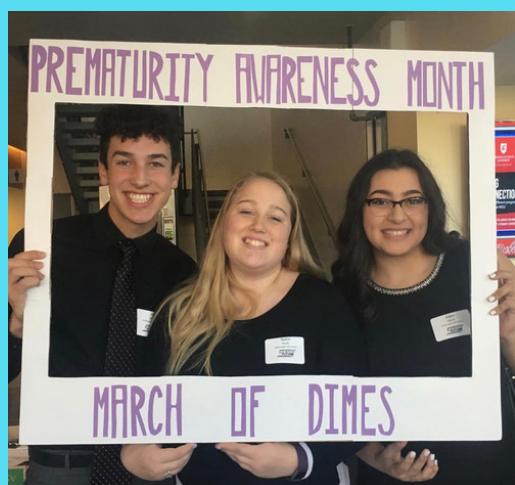


1.) WHAT MOD DOES

The March of Dimes is a U.S. based nonprofit organization that works to improve the health of mothers and babies by preventing birth defects, premature birth, and infant mortality.
