# **Lead4Change**

Lead4Change does change students - in a powerful way! Findings confirm that Program participants are making meaningful changes in their self-assessments of leadership and social emotional skills. Visit their Web site at <a href="https://www.lead4change.org/">https://www.lead4change.org/</a> to see how you can get involved!

The participants in Lead4Change's first full research study conducted during the 2018-19 school



year showed changes in all but three of the 78 items measured. Grouping the 78 items into 10 key social emotional factors, student participants showed statistically significant positive changes on 6 of 10 factors.

#### The six factors are:

- Leadership
- Self-Efficacy
- Perspective-taking
- Self-Management
- Commitment to Vision
- And Ambition & Innovation
